If You See Something, Say Something

It is highly unlikely that an employee may discover an explosive device within the Texas City site. Regardless of the odds, everyone at the Texas City site should remain observant of their surroundings and never take suspicious situations for granted.



Every day somewhere in the United States, suspicious situations are reported by observant citizens and investigated by law enforcement. A number of these investigations involve improvised explosive devices, more commonly known as IED's. IED's are home made devices using improvised materials that are easily obtained. They have been discovered in neighborhoods and work environments. In many cases the origin of the IED, or the reason they were left behind, remain a mystery. The photo to the left depicts a pipe bomb (IED) recovered by law enforcement.

Recently, within our site, an employee noticed a suspicious item that seemed out of the ordinary. BP Security was not contacted until after the item was disturbed. Failure to take proper action in this situation could have resulted in serious harm. Fortunately in this case the item was harmless. The photo to the right shows the suspicious item.
